

# Hong Kong ICT Awards 2015 Opens for Enrolment



A prestigious event in the information and communications technology (ICT) industry, the Hong Kong ICT Awards (HKICTA) is held annually to celebrate creative solutions of ICT professionals and enterprises in enhancing the quality of living for the public.

Now open for enrolment, HKICT Awards 2015 aims to encourage local ICT talents and enterprises in their continuous pursuit of innovation and excellence, and in the development of innovative ICT products, applications and solutions.

Mirroring the Government's policy to develop a smarter city leveraging technologies, a new award category named "Best Smart Hong Kong Award" is introduced this year, according to Daniel Lai, the Government Chief Information Officer and Chairman of the Steering Committee.

Other award categories include Best Business Solution; Best Digital

Entertainment; Best Digital Inclusion; Best ICT Startup; Best Innovation; Best Lifestyle; Best Mobile Apps; Best SME ICT; and Best Student Invention.

Led by Professor Way Kuo, President of the City University of Hong Kong, the Grand Adjudication Panel will also select the "Award of the Year" among the 10 award categories.

Steered by the Office of the Government Chief Information Officer, HKICT Awards 2015 is organized by 10 local industry associations and professional bodies selected through a rigorous exercise.

Enrolment in the HKICT Awards 2015 closes on January 16, 2015.
